Lady Bird Johnson Wildflower Center

Founded in 1982 the National Wildflower Research Center was started by Lady Bird Johnson and Helen Hayes and was originally located on a 60 acres site in East Austin. It was later moved to it's current location on a 42 acre site in Southwest Austin in 1995 and officially names for Lady Bird in 1997.

By 2002 the Center had acquired 237 acres due to encroaching land development. As a gathering spot for all those interested in native plants and conservation, it has become a leader in education and outreach to preserve and restore healthy landscapes in central Texas.

The Wildflower Center joined the University of Texas at Austin in 2006.
